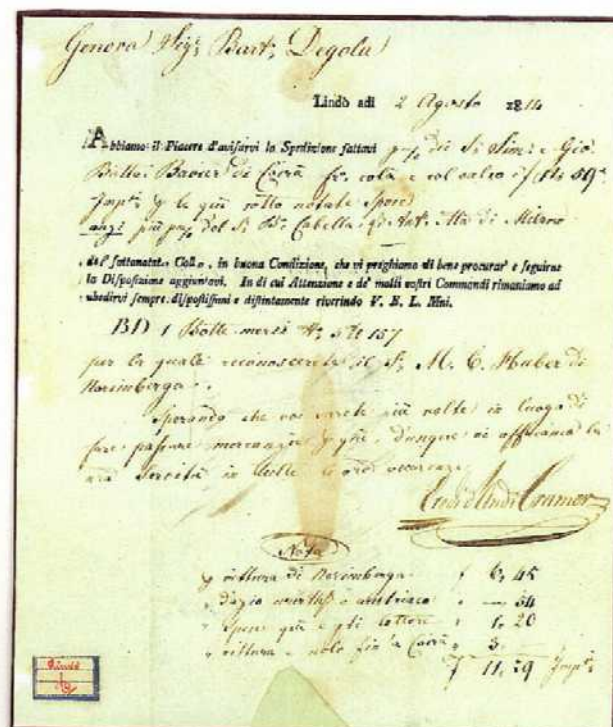
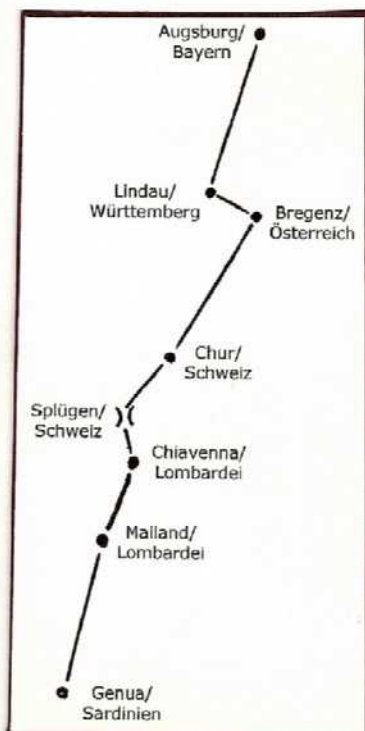

Transport of Freight

The **Lindau Carrier** was an association of several private transport companies. It mainly carried parcels across the Swiss Alps. It also was permitted to handle mail from Lindau via Bregenz, Chur, die Graubünden passes (usually the Splügen pass) and Chiavenna to Milan by the German States, Austria and the Swiss cantons until 1826.

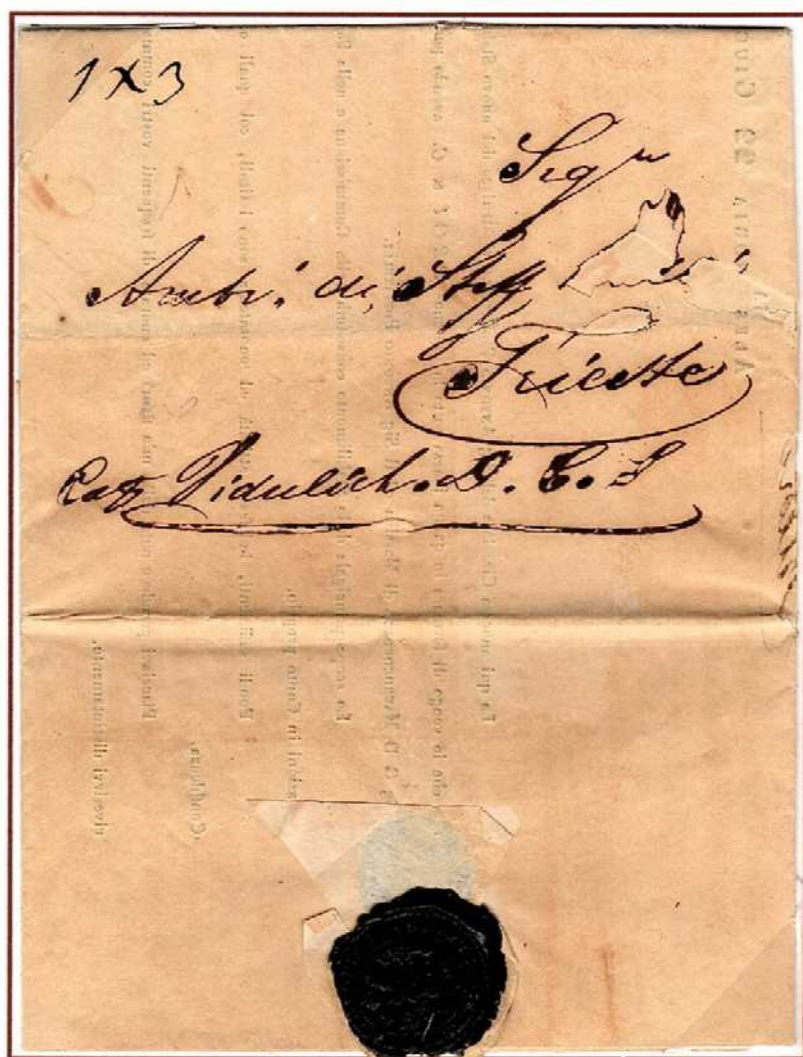

Ship-mail from Ottoman Egypt to Trieste, 1835



Commercial letter to a Trieste merchant dated Alexandria, 22 June 1835. Carried to Trieste on the ship of *Capt. Vidulich D.C.S* (whom God protect). Disinfected in Trieste at the Santa Theresa lazaretto and closed with the 22 x 24mm black wax seal with text **S. DEL LAZARETTO DI S. TER. DI TRIESTE**

The disinfection fees charged by the Lazaretto are marked on the front: **1 x 3**, i.e. one sheet at 3kr fee per sheet = 3kr charged to the recipient in addition to the postage.

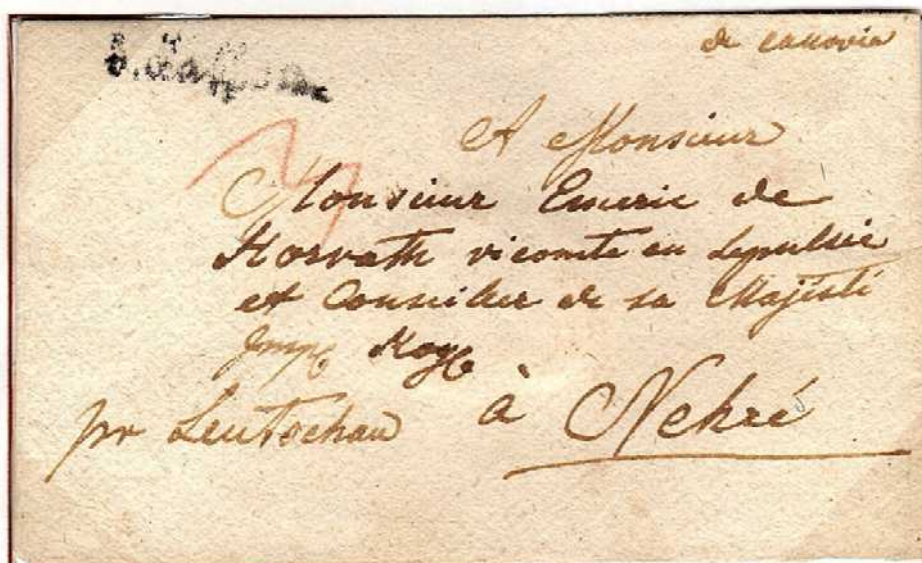

CASCHAU

The town's first postmark is in gothic script, and is recorded by Müller as **v. Caschau**, although Gudlin describes it as **v. Kaschau**. Decide for yourself whether the first letter is a "C" or a "K"! The postmark is known in black (and rarely in red), and has been recorded in use from 1782 to 1830.

Cover without contents, but with arrival date 1794 on the reverse. Marked in manuscript *de cassovie* and addressed in French to Vécse (now Vojčice in Slovakia), via Leutschau (= Lőcse, now Levoča). The postmark **v. Kaschau** represents uncommon use of a postmark during the Austrian "postmarkless period" of 1790-1818.

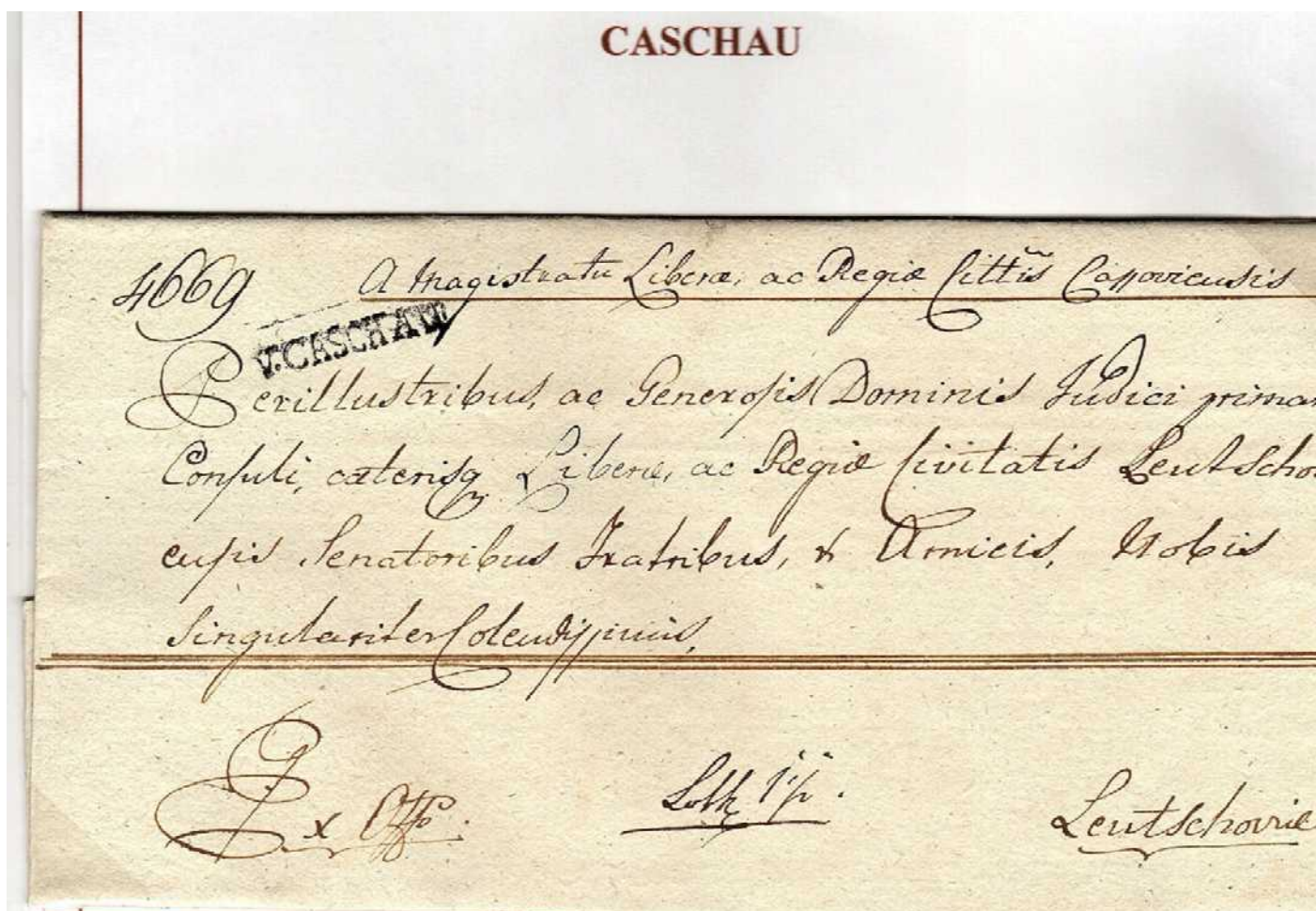

Official mail marked *ex offo* and therefore not subject to rating for postal charges. Marked only with the weight *1½ loth.*

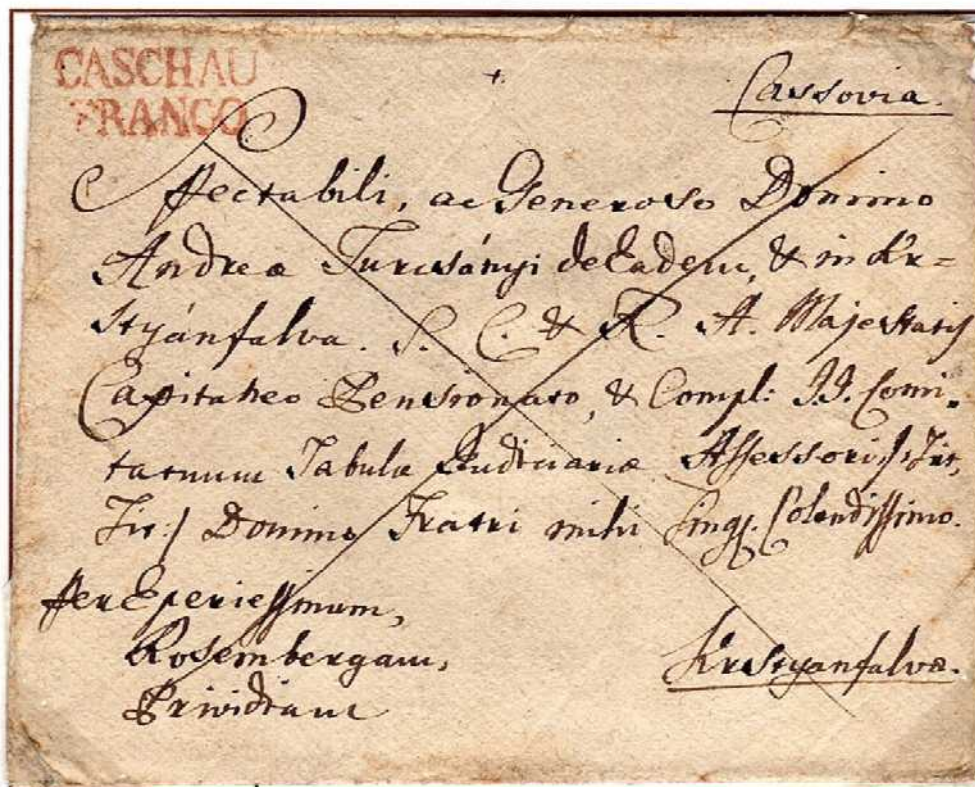
Private correspondence dated Kassa, 5 August 1830, and written in Hungarian to a father from his child. Addressed in French to Tokay and Nagy Károly (now Carei in Rumania). Pele (now Becheni) is a small town in Rumania, about 20km south of Karei.

Marked in manuscript *De Cassovie* and postmarked **V.KASCHAU**. Unpaid letter marked **8** kr for the addressee to pay; a letter weighing up to ½ loth for 10 to 12 postal zones (June, 1817 tariff.)

CASCHAU

This plain-oval type postmark v.CASCHAU was unknown to Müller, but was recorded by Ber et al from 1841 to 1842 and Gudlin from 1835 to 1839. Although Gudlin published more recently, the cover below suggests that Ber was correct.

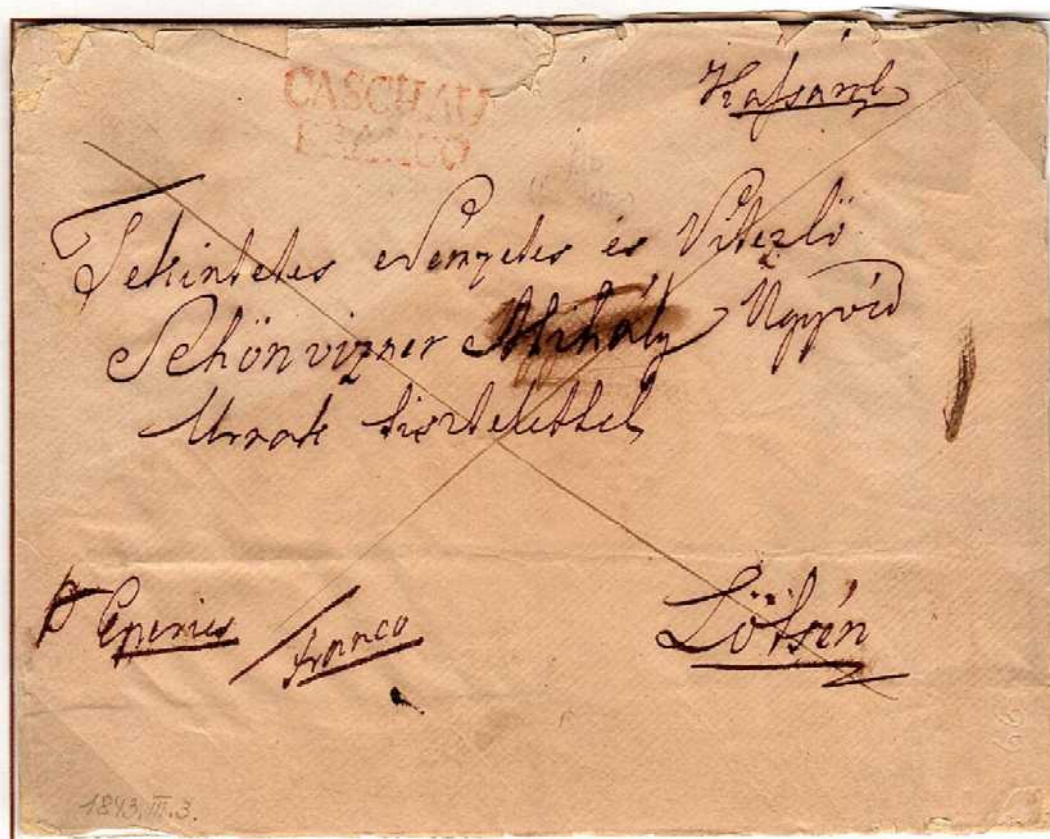


Folded letter written in German and dated Kaschau, 12 March 1842. Postmarked v. CASCHAU. Addressed to Czegled and marked 10 kr to pay; a lowest-weight letter for 13 to 15 postal zones.

Combined postmark **CASCHAU / FRANCO** used on fully-pre-paid
mail and hence always in red ink. Known in use from 1833 to 1842.

Envelope with full contents written in Hungarian and dated Kassa, 3
March 1843, a year after the latest usage recorded by Müller or
Gudlin. Marked in manuscript *Kassarol* (i.e. from Kassa), *p. Eperjes*
(i.e. via Prešov), and addressed to *Lotsen* (i.e. Lőcse = Leutschau, now
Levoča, in Slovakia).

The route would have taken the letter north to Eperjes and then west.
Levoča lies just south of the Tatra Mountains, some 25km east of
Poprad. Postmarked **CASCHAU / FRANCO** because the sender had
pre-paid the postage of 6 kr (marked on the reverse). This was the
lowest rate on the 1842 tariff, a letter of less than ½ loth travelling up
to ten meilen.

This letter sheet is addressed to the Lungau Iron Works Co. in Mauterndorf in Styria. It is backstamped with the 23mm d. circular arrival strike of **Mauterndorf** on $\frac{23}{6}$.

The correspondence within the letter sheet is clearly dated as 22nd June 1853.

Type III of this value has the re-engraved open border of the shield; a normal 'E' in Stempel, the head of the '6' detached from the frame and a coloured spot in the leaf.

The 3 Kreuzer red stamp on the above letter sheet has been cancelled with the Kirchdorf straight line strike dated 15. Mar.

This is a letter sheet addressed to Linz, the provincial capital of Upper Austria, and it has been struck on the reverse LINZ 16. MAR. as the arrival strike.

The correspondence within the letter sheet is clearly dated as 15th March 1854.

Type III of this value has the re-engraved open border of the shield whilst, with the Sub-Type III a, the final R of KREUZER is normal and there are no coloured spots.

The 5 Kreuzer red stamp on the above letter sheet has been cancelled with the **Salzburg** 30x25mm oval strike dated $\frac{12}{7}$.

This letter sheet has been addressed to T. Fuchtinger at Mondsee, in Upper Austria, and on the reverse has been struck with the **Mondsee** 23mm d. double circle arrival strike dated $\frac{13}{7}$.

Type II of this issue appeared in 1859 and is identified by the fact that the middle line of the loop in the nope of the neck is complete and joined to the wreath.
