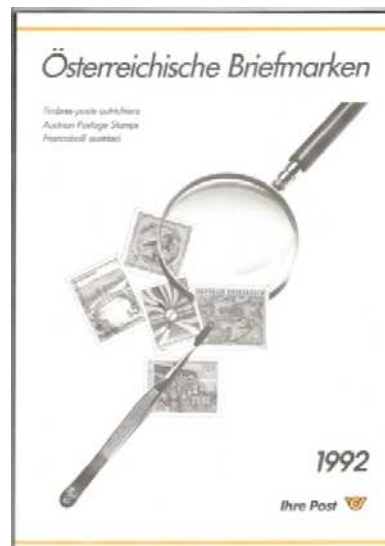

Alpach

Alpach is first mentioned in 1150, although a human settlement is known to have begun before. Alpach has been very isolated until a road has been built in 1926. Since 1945 Alpach has been the venue for the Alpach European Forum, an annual two weeks conference of leading figures from the world of Science, Business, the Arts and Politics. The Forum and participants of so many people who have shaped the thinking of their times has given Alpach the nickname 'the village of thinkers'.

(7) NICOPOL

An ancient Roman stronghold on the southern bank of the Danube, 90 miles east of Lom-Palanka, NICOPOLIS (in Greek "Victory-Town") derived its name from a victory of Emperor Trajan over the Dacians. In 1396, it was the scene of another memorable encounter, when the Ottoman Sultan Bayazid I inflicted a crushing defeat to an army of Crusaders led by Christian Europe in an attempt to rescue Bulgaria and Serbia, just conquered by the Turks. Under the Ottoman rule which followed, Nicopolis sank to the level of a large village (population 4,662 in 1888). Present Bulgarian name: NICOPOL.

It is only in 1852 that an Agency of the D.D.S.G. was opened at Nicopol, when the ships of the Company began to call at this fluvial port. It would appear that, until 1865, letters were given uncanceled to the ships. A stampless letter of 1865 with Type 1 was recorded by Mueller. As from April, 1866, letters were franked with the stamps of the D.D.S.G., but material from Nicopol is scarcer than from most other Bulgarian ports.

The Agency discontinued its postal service in 1880.

(a) Cancellations.



Type 1: 32 x 23 mm. oval, with 3-line AGENTIE/D.D.S.G./NICOPOL (this latter curved), no date (Fig. 905).

In Standard Type "U" (see page 11), an all-purpose marking used as a Hand-struck Stamp on stampless letters from 1865 to 1866, then as a Canceller on postage stamps until the 1870s. Colour: BLUE.

Type 2: 23 mm. single-circle, NICOPOL at top, date 2 lines (Fig. 906).

In Standard Type "V" (see page 11), introduced as a Canceller on postage stamps ca. 1866, current until 1880. Colour: BLUE.

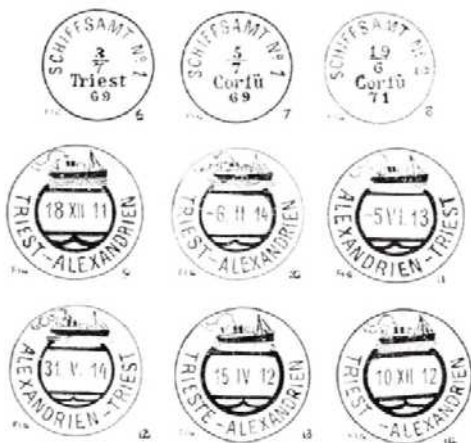

tion the COL VAP DA mark was applied. Again the absence of covers makes this impossible to establish.

One item relating to Jaffa was the application of the Col Vap Da on an uncanceled 1902 Great Britain 1d K.E. VII stamp which was posted on a British ship. No inset was used but the Jaffa date stamp was applied alongside the stamp. (See ASC 4-1966).

The arrival marks of Constantinople applicable to this volume are the SMIRNE (fig. 19) and BERUTTI (fig. 20) in an oval inscribed "Col Vapore Da" meaning "By steamship from" and these two are normally met on stampless covers up to 1864 and thereafter on the stamps of the Levant offices. In blue officially until 1864 but sometimes found up to 1883, and in black officially after 1864. These marks were introduced in 1861 and were officially current until 1875, although later use is known.

D.D.S.G. Lines, Asia Minor—Egypt

1. Constantinople-Smyrna, inaugurated December 1834 (terminated in 1845).

In 1834 the Maria Dorothea left Triest on her maiden voyage to Constantinople and on arrival secured a contract to transport the mail bags of the Austrian Consular Post between Constantinople and Smyrna previously entrusted to English vessels.

In 1839 the service was weekly. Itinerary: Constantinople, Gallipoli, Dardanelles, Cape Baba, Mytilene, Smyrna.

2. Constantinople-Beirut-Alexandria. The creation of this line was decided in 1838 but the actual operation of a regular service remains questionable, although experimental trips may have been made. No material is recorded.

The two PAID marks of the D.D.S.G. used at Smyrna are illustrated in figs. 21 and 22. Both are rare, no copies recorded in the Steindler sale.

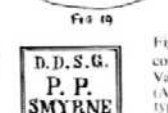

During 1820-1837 the Austrian Navy made an attempt to organise a mail service between Triest and Alexandria (also Triest-Constantinople) but when ships of the Lloyd commenced operations the service was discontinued. No postal markings of the naval service are recorded.

Giurgevo

Giurgevo (Romanian Giurgiu; Turkish Yergöğü) is a town on the northern bank of the Danube opposite the Bulgarian town of Ruse (Ruschuk), some 30 miles south of Bucharest. It occupies the site of Theodorapolis, a city built in the sixth century AD by the emperor Justinian, and is said to have been given its present name in the 14th century by Genoese merchant adventurers in honour of San Giorgio the patron saint of Genoa. It became one of the leading southern towns of the principality of Wallachia. In 1417 Wallachia accepted the suzerainty of the Ottomans, but three years later the Ottomans seized Giurgevo in an effort to control Danube traffic. Giurgevo was often fought over, not least in July 1854 when Turkish troops, supported by a small British group, drove out the Russians during the Crimean war. In 1865 construction work began on the Bucharest-Giurgiu rail line, which was opened to traffic in August 1869. Giurgevo was one of the main outlets on the river for traffic to and from Bucharest, including the mail-carriers.

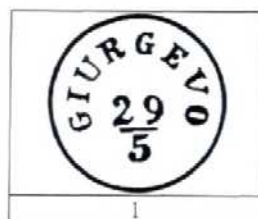

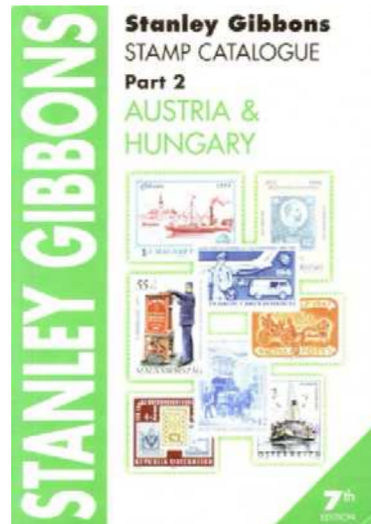
